EXAMPLE - There are 5 questions related to "PROVIDING RESIDENT'S RIGHTS."

Number of students who tested = 17

Total questions in the Providing Resident's Rights Duty Area is $(17 \times 5) = 85$

According to this report 4 of those questions were missed (81 were correct).

81 out of 85 questions in this duty area were answered correctly. $81/85 = 95.29\%$

There are **75** scored questions for each monthly exam. An additional **10** questions are tested as field items for future exams. Only those task related questions that students miss in each duty area are listed on the report.

The "No. Missed" divided by the "No. Answered" results in the "% Missed" column. If 7 out of 17 students missed a question on "ASSIST RESIDENT WITH OTHER PERSONAL GROOMING", the percentage of students that missed the task related question was 41.18%.

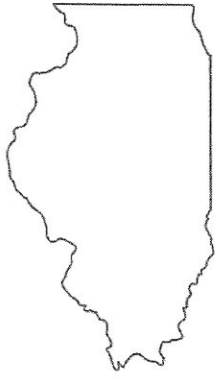
