ANATP/BNATP Monthly Update June 2021

- All temporary waivers for clinicals, labs, etc. expired on May 31, 2021. Beginning June 1st, all BNATPs/ANATPs must provide 40 hours of face to face clinicals. Online theory hours are only allowed for programs approved as a hybrid. Vocational programs (private businesses) must have IBHE approval for a new hybrid format before IDPH can give approval.
- 2. No student can be admitted to a BNATP or ANATP without a valid social security number. There are no exceptions to this and no waivers! This includes high school students even though high school students do not require background checks. Entries must be made in the HCWR for all students and this entry requires a social security number. Without an SSN, the student cannot take the certification exam because the INACE system requires one also.
