1. The look of the ITIN has changed to make it look less like a Social Security card.



2. When requesting an instructor code, please send **only** the documents that are listed on the instructor code request and approval form. I do not want diplomas, nursing licenses, transcripts, etc.
3. RNs who are approved instructors in an accredited LPN or RN program do not need to complete CEUs for instructor approval to teach in a BNATP. I would only need their resume/CV and the instructor code request form.
4. Please keep these updates in your monitoring visit binder.
5. It was great meeting everyone at the annual conference! Looking forward to next year already!
6. Monitoring visit clarification: Violations of administrative code on the first visit will result in a Corrective Action Plan (CAP). If upon subsequent visits there are violations of the same nature, regardless of the time lapsed between visits, your program will be placed on probation for 180 days. During that 180-day period, there will be another unannounced



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visit. If violations of the same nature are found during that probationary period, your program will be revoked for two years.
