ANATP/BNATP Monthly Update August 2025

- 1. I will no longer be generating instructor code letters. You will receive an email with the instructor code.
- 2. We are working on revising the certification exam and adding additional questions to bring it to a total of 105 questions, ten of which will not be graded. This should be implemented soon. Notification of this will be online when you enter a roster as a reminder that the test has additional questions.
- 3. Note that the annual CNA Instructors Conference dates have been changed to April 30 and May 1, 2026. There was a conflict with another conference that many instructors were already scheduled to attend. The format of a half day on Thursday and a full day on Friday will be the same as the 2025 conference.
- 4. Medication Aide training has moved to the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules. This is the last look for the legislature before it goes to public notice. It has to be published for 45 days for a public comment period. It will then have a second public notice of 45 days. After that, it will be published as law. It will be a minimum of another 100 days before we can accept applications for the program. Notification will be by monthly update when you can begin.
