



ANATP/BNATP Monthly Update June 2026

1. There were no updates for May 2026.
2. Please discontinue using “Access Worker” as a position category when entering Livescan requests. This is not to be used for CNAs. The drop down specifically states not to use for CNAs after April 2024. Please choose “Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) Training Program.”
3. **All facility-based programs entering students into the [HCWR](#):** Many of your students will already be entered into the HCWR by the facility and already have a background check. However, the **BNATP** program **must have a separate login** to the HCWR **from the sponsor facility**, even though they may never do any background checks. The **PC must request access**, if they do not have it, to the HCWR to **obtain a login** to the DPH Web Portal. This will allow the **PC to enter the training program start and end dates** in the Training and Work History section. This will then show where the student received their training.
4. If there are errors made when entering information into the rosters, either the PC or the student should contact Southern Illinois University-Carbondale at inat@siu.edu to correct the submission. You should be viewing all photo IDs for verification of the name spelling, dates of birth, and the Social Security numbers for all students. So far in 2026, there have been an extraordinary number of data entry errors made. *Do not create additional rosters to fix errors! Contact SIUC.*
5. **Monthly HCWR training.** This is for new PCs or other staff who enter information into the registry or initiate background checks. It is mandatory for new programs (excluding programs that are just adding extension sites). Anyone can attend. This one will be on Wednesday, June 17th from 12:00 p.m. to 1:00 p.m. It is my goal to have this training monthly on/about the 15th of each month. The WebEx link will change monthly, so check the monthly updates for the link.
